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ELIGIBLE CUSTOMERS

- Commercial and Industrial members of Barry Electric Cooperative are eligible for energy efficiency incentive grants. Equipment must be installed in facilities served by the Cooperative.
- Funding is limited. Incentive grants are available on a first come, first served basis during any calendar year and quarterly review period.

ELIGIBLE ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROJECTS

- Incentives are available only for projects that result in the conservation of electricity, including but not limited to lighting, premium efficiency motors and variable speed drives, compressed air measures, HVAC, water heating, chillers and refrigeration, commercial kitchen equipment, commercial clothes washers and dryers, heat recovery (electric), office equipment or vending machines.
- The Cooperative will target projects with a simple payback of at least 1.5 years but no more than 4 years.
- Project incentives are available for a maximum of 30% of project costs, with a facility maximum incentive of \$100,000.

APPROVAL PROCESS

- All incentive grants must be pre-approved by the Cooperative **BEFORE ANY EQUIPMENT IS PURCHASED OR INSTALLED**
- **Applicants must complete the application form for each energy efficiency measure.** Multiple applications for different measures may be submitted, but each measure will be evaluated on its own merits.
- Incomplete applications will not be processed and will be returned to the member.
- Commercial and industrial energy efficiency incentive grants will be individually determined by the Cooperative based on the electricity savings and the useful life of measure.
- The Cooperative will respond to incentive applications with an authorization letter showing the amount of the grant, if any, that is pre-approved. This letter is your authorization that the incentive payment will be approved.
- Please allow at least 6-8 weeks for processing the application. Please keep a copy for your records.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Installation must be completed by appropriately qualified personnel or contractors.
- Members must work with an Associated Electric Cooperative account manager or energy audit partner to receive a project incentive grant.
- An inspection of the installed equipment will be scheduled and performed following installation.
- Applicant may be required to measure and verify equipment performance and/or energy savings.
- Incentive payments are made in the form of checks, not energy bill credits. **Payments will be made following the verified installation of the project.**
